- Create Technical documentation for future reference and support using confluence.

- Strong hands-on experience on AWS stack like ECS, ECR, EKS, Lambda, EC2, Elastic Load Balancers, SQS, Amazon MQ, S3, CloudFront, RDS – Aurora MySQL and DocumentDB
- Experience in turning requirements into User Stories, Story Slicing, Estimation & breaking those down into EPICS.
- Good stakeholder management skills with the ability to influence upwards and prioritise effectively to sustain delivery momentum.
